

Pastor's Message

As I was heading for the back door of our house, my daughter, only seven years old at the time, asked me where I was going. I told her that I was going to officiate at the funeral service for a member of our congregation and I mentioned the member's name. My daughter recognized the name. She looked up and innocently asked, "Will he be all right, Dad?" I was taken back by the

simplicity of my daughter's question but then I realized the beauty of it. "Yes," I replied, "he will be all right."

Easter this year is April 20. The Lenten season will come to a glorious end as we celebrate once again the victory of our Lord Jesus Christ over what Martin Luther would call "sin, death, and the devil." Easter marks the Resurrection of our Lord! We will have made the journey with Jesus from his triumphal entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday (April 13) through the perplexity of Maundy Thursday (April 17) and the agony of Good Friday (April 18) to the shouts of joy on Easter Sunday.

Jesus' journey, in many respects, is our journey as we struggle with adversity. Our adversity may take many different forms. Are we happy with what is happening in the world? Does the weight of the crosses that we carry wear us out? The good news of Jesus' resurrection empowers us to say to all that threatens to overwhelm us: Stop! Christ is risen! While flowers bring beauty to our celebration of Jesus' resurrection, the message of Easter is something more. The mystery of the discarded stone and the empty tomb brings an unfailing and unwavering hope to our lives. Nothing can top that and, yes, when all is completed, we too will be all right.
