Pastor's Message

The summer is quickly drawing to a close, and I hope that this season has given you the opportunity to step out of your normal routine and do some different things. Indeed, this is part of the refreshment and rejuvenation that sabbath-keeping in the Hebrew Scriptures sought to provide.

Many of us find ourselves struggling with the state of the world in which we currently live. The list of concerns and challenges that we face is a list too long, and I would rather focus our attention on how we respond. I subscribe to the *Daily Meditations* provided digitally by the Henri Nouwen Society. All these meditations have been written by the much revered Henri Nouwen. One in particular, entitled "Live in the World as a Child of God," caught my attention and I found it especially helpful. I share it with you:

There is no promise that everything will be rosy. The first thing is not to play savior of the world but to keep living in the world as a child of God. I see all these things happening, but I do not allow them to seduce me into the darkness. I live in the world but belong to God.
